### Event Status/Updates

- Coronation Event wrapup
  - Overall, the event went well – but it did have its hiccups.
  - Ideas that came up at the last staff meeting. These were great ideas! Just too late – they should have been communicated earlier in the planning process.
  - There will be more scrutiny when reviewing event budgets with regard to site contract/requirements. It wasn't caught that there is a \$3.00/person fee to be paid to the BSA for everyone that daytrips the event. This had to come out of what we (and kingdom) kept after paying the BSA for the site. Expect future event bids to take an extra month to be approved so that budgetary concerns can be paid better attention to.
  - We were running thin with people. The event went well but we needed more people in each area of concern in order for things to run even smoother. In some cases people were filling several different roles.
  - Table sign-up sheets for feast will be used at future events. This doesn't seem to be a problem with baronial events but is a must at larger kingdom-level events.
