Total Account Balance on January 1, 2012 was \$5,144.49. We are currently operating at a loss of \$1,739.65. The following is a break-down of our expenses this year:

It was noted that there is approximately 500.00 laid out for Investiture, IB12, MAAD, and Coronation. If these events break even then that money would come back to the general fund. This may help our financial situation but only a little. We need to make approximately \$1000.00/year to cover our operating costs and so far we have not made anything from the two events we have hosted so far this year.

Check #1177 in the amount of \$600.00 written to the Boy Scouts Association on 05/21/2012 for the site fee for Courtier's Challenge has not cleared our bank account yet. I have been in contact with the BSA.

- Allesandra stated that the check was delivered and that she was told that it was lost at the Boy Scout Council offices. The check needs to be cancelled and reissued. It was also noted that \$50.00 of the total 600.00 had already been paid in the form of a deposit and that the check should be for \$550.00
