Knight Marshal:

- Official Armored Combat, Rapier Combat, Youth Combat, and Combat Archery practices have resumed per SCA / Kingdom easing of COVID-19 related restrictions. Armored Combat, Rapier Combat, Youth Combat and Combat Archery practices schedule is to be every Sunday 1:00pm at Great Bridge Lock Park, Chesapeake.
