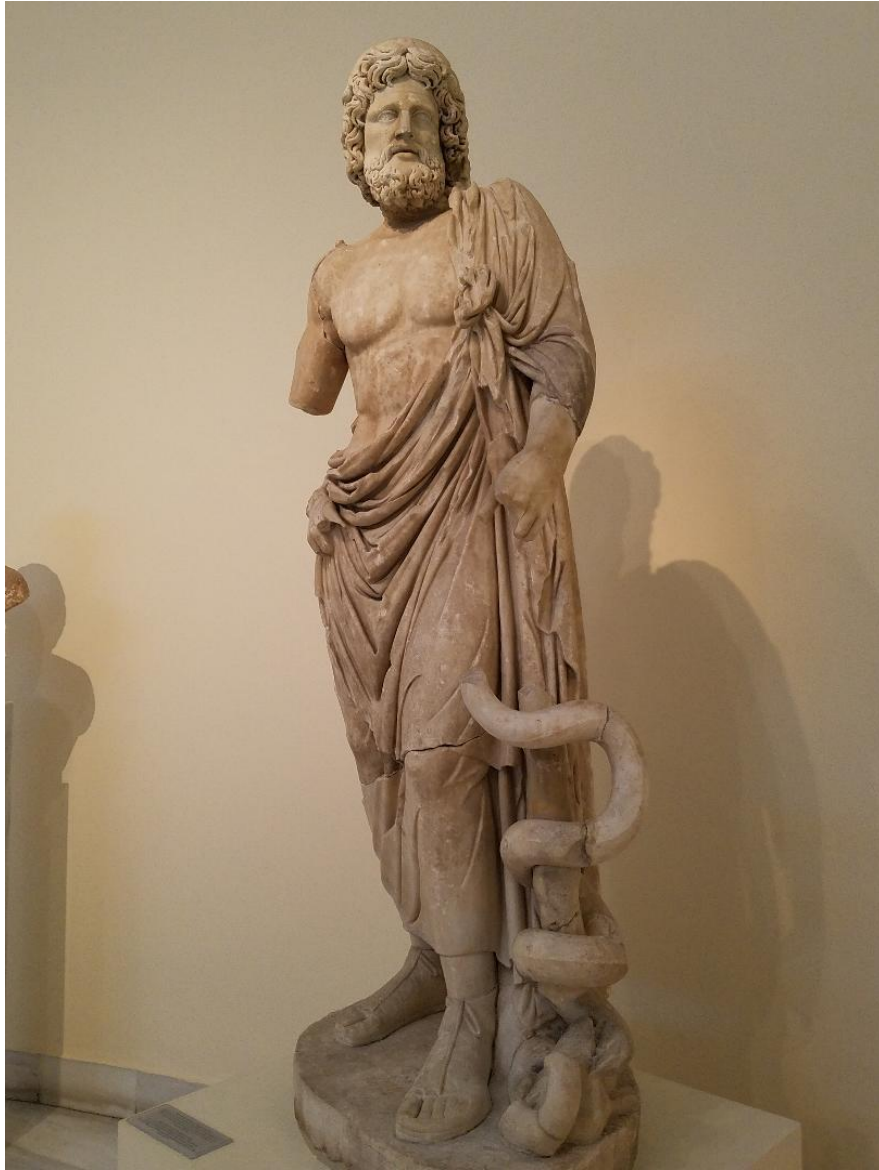

Alexandria Sanguini. Name reconsideration from Alexandria Sangrini and badge. (Fieldless) In pale a feather fracted in chevron inverted purpure conjoined to a goutte de sang. When originally registering this name, we misunderstood the submitter's intent and thus registered the name as Alexandria Sangrini. In this request for reconsideration, the submitter made clear that she desires the attested byname Sanguini. We are happy to grant reconsideration and make this change.

Thomas de Kilbride. Name and device. Per chevron Or and azure, two flesh-hooks inverted their handles in saltire sable and an ass sejant argent.

Nice Scots name for the late 13th through 15th centuries!

Exchequer:

1. We currently enjoy a bank balance of \$ 8,764.63 which balanced with our latest bank statement which arrived today (Saturday, April 11th). (Signatures required...)

2. Finally got together with the Airline Self-Storage manager (Cindy Thornburg 757-488-2000) and received some good news. By paying annually we get one month rent free so we only owe \$ 935.00 for the year (roughly \$ 78.00 per month [vice \$ 85.00 per month or \$ 1,020.00 annually]). We normally pay every July but I have check ready for signature now. (Mostly to move the date away from our normally busy months.)

3. I am working on our 2020 First Quarter Exchequer's report and should have that ready for submission by the end of next week.
