Exchequer:

- We currently enjoy a balance of \$ 4,595.27 as of this 6th day of June in the year 2019. [Account balanced on the first attempt – Whoopie!]
- Khedive Temple site deposit has not been recovered yet. [\$ 1,000.00]. Baroness Catalina will coordinate cancellation and retrieval of deposit check.
- Check for the Annual Storage Unit Fee has been written and awaits the signature of our short-timer Seneschal before delivery to the storage facility will waylay our obligation for another year.
- I would like everyone who holds any baronial property to inventory said property and submit an identifying descriptive list with quantities to me at the next MOOT (July 9th, 2019) so that I may make up a master inventory list to post with our Quartermaster and possibly the website if that be feasible. I will make myself available for anyone who requires aide to get this accomplished.
- The large baronial pavilion (20 X 30) and the small baronial pavilion (20 X 24) worked well at Ruby Joust. Some repair will be needed on the small pavilion - A small patch is needed to cover a two-inch tear in the canvas and the poles could use some refurbishing. The new corner poles worked well on the large pavilion – Thank You Lord Ivarr for heading up the project to manufacture those. He also has some ideas about fixing the ridge pole to ease transportation woes. Perimeter poles also need some refinishing. Pictures have been taken of the full pavilion kits and hopefully will be viewable online soon.
