Exchequer:

1. All bills are paid and the Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of **\$ 7,666.19**. Account balanced 11/08/2020 after receiving the bank statement on Saturday, 11/08. (*signatures required*).
2. All local Bank Account Signatories have signed the signature card and the bank's required paperwork has been forwarded to Virginia Regional for her signature who will then pass it on to the Kingdom Exchequer. (*You would not believe how much time and correspondence this took to get accomplished.*) Thank you all for coming forward and taking up the reins of baronial service.
- 3 I am still in the process of revising the format of the Barony's Financial Policies to conform with the new template. Cindy and I will be getting together soon to polish up the new document. With that in mind, I foresee a full Financial Committee meeting toward the end of the month and a Moot presentation to vote on its adoption. We have until December 31st, 2020 to have our changes made, approved and submitted to the Kingdom Exchequer via our Regional Exchequer for inclusion to the Kingdom of Atlantia official website. 4. It is also time for us to conduct an inventory of all Baronial Property.
