War of the Wings is coming and for those of you that are going, We will not be able to be there but know that we will be with you in spirit. If you are going, please let Baron Mungo know as he is coordinating the encampment for the event. He will need things like prospective head-count for campers. For those that haven't been, it's a great event to attend.

Exchequer:

1. We currently enjoy a bank balance of \$ 8,942.97 which balanced with our latest bank statement which arrived today (Monday, October 7th).
2. Though the numbers are not absolutely final, I can report the following in good faith: Rip Rap War III took in approximately \$5,579.34 as determined by our deposits. Our recorded outlay was approximately \$2,412.67. This tallies up to a \$3,166.67 gain. There are a few outstanding receipts that we are waiting on for the final accounting.
3. The Tollner for Rip Rap War III has received two requests for refunds from people who had medical problems and were physically unable to attend.

4. The Marinus Financial Committee met and conducted a thorough Financial Policy Review. Several wording changes were discussed and incorporated into a revised Financial Policy. Hopefully there will be copies to hand out at the meeting with an electronic copy to be furnished to the Webminister for publishing on our website.
5. I am in receipt of a letter from the Airline Self-Storage facility informing us of a \$15.00 per month increase in our storage unit fee effective November 1st, 2019. This will bring our annual payment up to \$ 1,020.00 if we do not receive any discounts for paying annually. This increase will fund improvements in the units to include an electronic gate (no word if that means expanded hours of operation), unit repairs, better lighting, security cameras, paving, drainage, better parking and more of it. I will be talking with them to ascertain whether we will owe more for the remainder of this year (since we generally pay each June putting us 6 months out.)
